The black duck is the principal game duck in Eastern Canada.

The breeding grounds extend from the Great Lakes and Hudson's Bay to Labrador. They nest near water, but lay from 5 to 14 eggs.

The ducklings learn to fly by August, and are ready to migrate in September. In late November, migration to the wintering grounds of the Atlantic Coast begins.

The diet of the black duck consists of wild rice, grasses, seeds, and shellfish.
