Even after many years of study, biologists are unable to agree on the number of races of the Canada goose.

The largest, as well as one of the smallest geese native to North America, are within the Canada goose category, marked by black neck and head and prominent white cheek patch.

The pale coloured giant honker of the eastern prairies may weigh 18 pounds or more, while the small dark cackler of the Pacific area barely matches the weight of a big mallard duck.
