Millions of bison once roamed the prairies. Overhunting made them extinct.

Today, many of Canada's animal and plant species are endangered not by hunting and trapping, but by the more insidious threats of habitat destruction and environmental pollution: the whooping crane, endangered by loss of habitat; the peregrine falcon, endangered by deadly pesticides; the swift fox, extinct in Canada because of loss of habitat.
